Document Name: Dual Enrollment Policy  
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### 1.0 Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to state Wasatch Charter School’s position on the dual enrollment of private school and home schooled students in the school. Utah Code states that students may be dually enrolled in both the school and in a private school or home school under the conditions stated below:

### 3.0 Policy Content

A parent seeking to dually enroll a student must certify that the student will receive instruction in the subjects the State Board of Education requires to be taught in public schools and for the same length of time as required in K-6 public schools, as provided by the rules of the State Board of Education.

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All students of Wasatch Charter School must be enrolled in the school for at least ¾ of each school day. Therefore, no student of Wasatch Charter School will be allowed to dually enroll if they do not plan to attend at least ¾ of each school day.

A contract between WCS and the parents outlining the times that students will attend and the educational instruction to be received in each setting will be drafted and signed by both the parents / guardians and the Director and maintained in the student’s file along with the certification.

Requests for dual enrollment should be provided to the Director of Wasatch Charter School. Students who are dually enrolled at Wasatch Charter School and in a private school or home school will only take the state assessments for the subjects for which they received instruction from Wasatch Charter School.
