1.0 Purpose

WCS will comply with the requirement of R277-483 of the Utah Administrative Code.

2.0 Definition

“Persistently dangerous” shall have the same meaning as set forth in administrative code R277-483.

3.0 Policy Content

If the school is designated by the Utah State Board of Education as persistently dangerous, parents of all students attending the school shall be notified by the Wasatch Charter School Governing Board of available transfer schools in a reasonable manner by no later than August 15 of the school year of designation.

Students who have been disciplined for any of the violations leading to the designation of the persistently dangerous school forfeit the right to transfer under this policy.

Students who exercise their right to transfer and continue attendance at another school will not be required to return to WCS upon the de-designation of the school as persistently dangerous.
