Traffic, Drop-Off and Pick-Up

We so appreciate the effort that was made to be on time this morning. We noticed a significant increase in the number of students being dropped off early in the drop-off window. We will continue having the chain down from 8:15 to 8:25, so keep up the good work! This morning, the traffic was slower than we hope it will be going forward. This is because of the caution tape around the new grass on the field; we noticed that most parents were not letting their children out of the cars along the caution tape. In addition to the new grass, there is a new strip of sidewalk that runs along the edge of the driveway. Students CAN be dropped off along the caution tape!

Please drop your children off along the full width of the field, even though there is caution tape. Instruct them to walk along the strip of sidewalk to go all the way down and around the taped-off area. This will speed the drop-off time significantly!
